When courses indicate low or zero material costs before registration, it helps you plan your schedule, choose options that fit your budget, and avoid surprises.

What are cost indicators?

They are symbols that tell you if the course you're registering for uses materials that are:

ZTC

= Zero
Textbook Cost
(\$0)

LTC

= Low
Textbook Cost
(typically under \$40)
